 - a. Review and recommendations for possible adoption of amendments to Texas Administrative Code, Title 22, Part 17, Chapter 361, Administration, in accordance with Texas Government Code Sec. 2001.039.
 - b. Review and recommendations for possible adoption of the repeal of Texas Administrative Code, Title 22, Part 17, Chapter 363, in accordance with Texas Government Code Sec. 2001.039.
 - c. Review and recommendation for possible adoption of new Texas Administrative Code, Title 22, Part 17, Chapter 363, including a review of comments received during the 30-day public comment period, in accordance with Texas Government Code Sec. 2001.039.
6. Adjourn.

The Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners may go into a closed meeting after first convening in an open meeting and stating the authority under which the closed meeting will be held in the open meeting in accordance with Section 551.101 of the Open Meetings Act.

Public comment shall be limited to 3 minutes per person.

Section 46.035 of the Texas Penal Code prohibits handgun licensees from carrying their handguns at government meetings, such as this one. This prohibition applies to both concealed carry and open carry by handgun licensees. Handgun licensees are required by law to refrain from carrying their handguns at this meeting.
