Job Description

This job description is not an employment agreement or contract. Management has the exclusive right to alter this job description at any time without notice.

The Plumbing Exam Center Maintenance Specialist performs routine building maintenance and construction work. Work involves maintaining and repairing buildings, utility systems, and stationary equipment; and operating motorized equipment. Works under moderate supervision, with limited latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment. This position will be headquartered at the Austin Examination center. This position works closely with the Exam staff to administer plumbing examinations and maintain equipment in the Austin Exam Center. The position may be required to travel to other exam centers in Waco and Harlingen.

Attendance and punctuality are required work attributes. This position is not eligible as a work-from-home position.

Essential Job Functions

- Performs maintenance, construction, and repair work such as masonry, welding, carpentry, painting, or mechanical work.
- Performs preventive maintenance on equipment, tools, and buildings. Operates and maintains motorized vehicles and equipment.
- Assists with the setup and break down of examination projects.
- May assist with the preventative maintenance and repair of machinery and equipment.
- May repair equipment and fabricate parts for repairs.

- May maintain records on work orders or projects. May perform inspections of operating machinery, equipment, and utility systems to ensure efficient and safe operations.
- Performs related work as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED. Graduation from a standard senior high school or equivalent.
- Experience in construction, maintenance, and repair work
- Valid Driver's License'
- Demonstrated use maintenance tools and equipment
- Ability to follow instructions; to work from drawings, diagrams, or blueprints; and to communicate effectively
- Basic computer literacy, including the use of email applications and word processing applications.
