

HIGH SCHOOL ACCELERATED TRAINING (HAT) PROGRAM

PLUMBER'S APPRENTICE REGISTRATION APPLICATION

Students enrolled in a qualified High School Training program are registered as standard Plumber's Apprentices but are not subject to initial application and renewal fees.

Minimum Requirements for the High School Accelerated Training (HAT) Apprentice Registration:

- Must provide proof that the applicant is authorized to work lawfully in the United States
- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- Fingerprints are required for all Apprentice Registrants. This is a one-time, state-mandated obligation that cannot be transferred between agencies. See the final page of this application for details.
- \$15 fee is waived for HAT participants.

If the Applicant has a Current Plumber's Apprentice Registration or Has Been Expired for Less than Two Years: DO NOT REAPPLY. Instead, please either renew the applicant's license online or call the TSBPE Licensing Department at 512-936-5248 to request a renewal form.

Processing Time: Allow up to 45 business days for the processing and return of your pocket card when sending applications via the US postal service.

Renewal of Registration: Plumber's Apprentice Registrations are assigned a random expiration date. The expiration date will be printed on the pocket card the applicant will receive after their registration application is approved. Apprentice registrations must be renewed each year on or before the expiration date. A renewal notice will be sent via email approximately 65 days before the registration's expiration date. **It is the Apprentice's responsibility to make sure his or her current address is on file with the Board.** All personal information can be updated quickly using the Online Licensing System: vo.licensing.hpc.texas.gov

The Applicant's Identity Will be Verified: Current (not expired) US or state government-issued photographic identification, such as a driver license, passport, or state-issued identification, must be submitted with this application.

Credit for Work Experience: When applying for a plumbing license or certain endorsements, applicants must submit proof of work experience in the plumbing trade. **APPLICANTS WILL ONLY RECEIVE CREDIT FOR HOURS WORKED IF THE WORK WAS COMPLETED WHILE THE APPLICANT HELD A CURRENT PLUMBER'S APPRENTICE REGISTRATION.**

 - One-time, electronic submission of fingerprint data through IdentoGO (see final page of this application)

FINGERPRINTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPRENTICES, PLUMBERS & INSPECTORS

TSBPE Identogo Service Code: **11J66Z**

Fingerprints are submitted electronically to the Department of Public Safety (DPS) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) through Identogo. The fee is \$39.05 and is collected by Identogo. This fee is *in addition to* your initial license or registration fees. Cash and personal checks are not accepted.

To register online:

1. Go to the TSBPE registration page on the Identogo website:
uenroll.identogo.com/workflows/11J66Z
2. Click “Schedule or Manage Appointment” and complete the pages that follow.
3. When asked for an Authorization code, mark “No.”
4. Do not request a hard card, as it will not be accepted by the TSBPE.
5. Make sure you bring proof of identification with you to the appointment.

To register by phone:

1. Call 1-888-467-2080. Use service code **11J66Z**. You **MUST** use this code. If you use the wrong code you will not be refunded for sending your information to another agency.
2. When asked for an Authorization code, answer “No.”
3. Do not request a hard card, as it will not be accepted by the TSBPE.
4. Make sure you bring proof of identification with you to the appointment.

Once completed, the background check will then be sent electronically to the TSBPE, but please keep the receipt as a precaution. **Fingerprint background checks for any other license or agency are not accepted as fingerprint data is not shared between State Agencies.** This service is NOT available at the TSBPE.
