

OUT-OF-STATE EXAMINATION REQUEST

If you are licensed to do plumbing work in Louisiana (LA) or Arkansas (AR), you may qualify for a reciprocal plumbing license. Please use the Online Licensing System (see web address/QR code at the bottom of this page) to submit your information. Click “Begin Here for Sign-Up” if you haven’t already created an account.

Minimum Requirements for an Out-of-State Examination:

- Must provide proof that the applicant is authorized to work lawfully in the United States
- Must be able to prove applicant is currently licensed as a Journeyman Plumber in another state
- Must have held the above license for two (2) years if coming from LA (and also hold a gasfitter’s license)
- Must submit non-refundable, examination processing fee (\$40)

The Applicant’s Identity Will be Verified: Current (not expired) US or state government-issued photographic identification, such as a driver license, passport, or state-issued identification, will be required from the applicant on the day of the examination.

Fingerprinting: Fingerprints are required for all out-of-state examinees. If you have not previously submitted fingerprints, see the last page of this application. This application will not be approved until corresponding fingerprint data is on file.

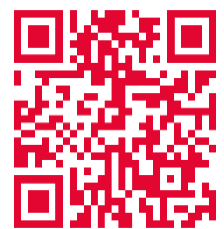
Waiting Periods for Examination Failures: The following waiting periods are required for any examination failure (all or part): (1) First failure: a 30-day waiting period, (2) Second failure, a 60-day waiting period, (3) Third and subsequent failures: a 90-day waiting period.

If the applicant requires special accommodations, please make such requests in writing and submit with this application for examination.

 - If applicant answered "yes" to question #9: **Supplemental Criminal History Information Form (SCHIF)** and required documents
 - If applicant answered "yes" to #10: a copy of applicant's active military ID or Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Military Duty (DD214)
 - One-time, electronic submission of fingerprint data through IdentoGO (see final page of this application). Check this box if applicant have already submitted your fingerprints via IdentoGO.

Here's What You Need to Know...

- If the applicant is a Journeyman from out-of-state, the examination they are required to take by the State of Texas is computer-based.
- All computer-based tests (CBTs) are administered by the TSBPE's testing partner Pearson VUE. Pearson VUE operates over 40 conveniently located testing locations across the state of Texas.
- When the applicant's request is approved* by the TSBPE, the applicant will receive an email from Pearson VUE that includes detailed instructions on how to schedule their Computer-Based Test.
- Once the applicant passes the computer-based test, the TSBPE will schedule their practical exam (if applicable) and send confirmation details and instructions via email.

FINGERPRINTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR PLUMBERS & INSPECTORS

TSBPE Identogo Service Code: **11J66Z**

New and renewal license/registration applicants are required to obtain a fingerprint background check. Fingerprints are submitted electronically to the Department of Public Safety (DPS) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) through Identogo. The fee is \$39.05 and is collected by Identogo. This fee is *in addition to* the applicant's initial license or renewal fees. Cash and personal checks are not accepted.

To register online:

1. Go to the TSBPE registration page on the Identogo website:

2. Click "Schedule or Manage Appointment" and complete the pages that follow.
3. When asked for an Authorization code, mark "No."
4. Do not request a hard card, as it will not be accepted by the TSBPE.
5. Make sure you bring proof of identification with you to the appointment.

To register by phone:

1. Call 1-888-467-2080. Use service code **11J66Z**. You **MUST** use this code. If you use the wrong code you will not be refunded for sending your information to another agency.
2. When asked for an Authorization code, answer "No."
3. Do not request a hard card, as it will not be accepted by the TSBPE.
4. Make sure you bring proof of identification with you to the appointment.

Once completed, the background check will then be sent electronically to the TSBPE, but please keep the receipt for record keeping purposes. **Fingerprint background checks for any other license or agency are not accepted as fingerprint data is not shared between State Agencies.** This service is NOT available at the TSBPE.
